

One Point Perspective Lesson Plan

1 Point Perspective Block Letters

Make a drawing using your initials. You can use your first name, last name or both. Use the 12"x18" paper.

Draw the face of the letters then draw the lines to the vanishing point. See example You will make the letters like the cubes in space. End the letter with a line to close the area going to the vanishing point. Now is should be a block letter.








The vanishing point should be in the middle of the paper so some the letter are below the vanishing point and some are above.


The letters that are above the vanishing point will show the bottom of the letters and the letters below the vanishing point will show the tops of the letters. Some of the sides will show depending where you put the letters on the paper.

Use your ruler to make your letters. The letters should be no smaller that 2". Start by making a square or a rectangle. Create what I call the face of your letter. Then make the edges of your letters go to the vanishing point. Next you will turn them into blocks like we did the cubes in space. Color the letters when you are done.
